Due to the strong industry contacts of WAAPA's highly experienced lecturers many students secure casual employment with some of WA's biggest backline and Production companies before they've even graduated; CCP, Audex, Matrix, AAAA. These industry connections also help WAAPA's P&D students gain workplace secondments at some of Australia's greatest venues and companies; Sydney Opera House, Belvoir, Cirque De Solei, House of Dancing Water, Britannia Row, Crown Casino and Perth Arena with many students securing employment as a direct result.
